### 2 FHC Dates, Times and Themes

#### 3 Attendance

Because we want each child to be properly prepared it is important that they attend as many of the session as possible. Because some children might miss a session through illness we have built into the programme various catch up sessions.

We have also been sensitive to school holidays so no sessions are planned to take place whilst children are off from school and families possibly away from home on holiday.

#### **4 Enrolment Mass**

Children planning to undertake their FHC preparation at St Paul's Dover will commence their FHC programme on Sunday 5th January by attending their 'Enrolment Mass' when each child, supported by a parent or guardian, formally enrols their child at the 9.15am Mass by publicly signing the enrolment agreement.

#### **5 First Session**

FHC classes at St Paul's commence on Sunday 12th January at 9am in St Paul's Presbytery which is immediately next to the church on the right hand side as you face the main entrance to the church.

Parents are welcome to attend the whole of the first session if they wish so that they can experience the environment where the preparation is going to take place and meet with those involved in preparing the children.

### 6 Second and Subsequent sessions:

### **Drop Off Time**

Children are to be dropped off by 8.55 am, St Paul's Presbytery along with their 'I Belong' book which they must bring with them each week.

The children who are being prepared will re join their families during mass as part of the offertory procession. Parents therefore should attend mass for this to happen otherwise the child becomes anxious if their parent or guarding is not there top meet them.

### 7 Homework

We very much want you, the parents, to be actively involved with your child's preparation. As such we request that you spend time with your child between the sessions to read through the material contained in the 'I belong' course book that each child will be given a free copy of at the start of their preparation programme.

This will provide you with an opportunity to see what your children are learning as well as assisting them in completing the various activities contained in the book such as: drawing pictures, colouring in, word searches, writing a prayer, sticking in pictures etc.

#### **8 First Reconciliation**

Fr Jeff will hear the St Paul's children's first reconciliation on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2020 immediately after the FHC practice.

All the children will make their first act of reconciliation one after the other. Parents are to be present throughout.

#### **9 First Holy Communion Practice**

A practice of the children receiving the host (and the precious blood for those children whose parents give their permission) for the first time will take place at St

Paul's Church on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June at 9.30am and immediately before Fr Jeff hears each child's first act of reconciliation.

### **10 First Holy Communion Masses**

First Holy Communion: Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> June 2020 at 9.15am or 11.30am according to final numbers.

Please bring your child to the presbytery by 9 am or 11.15 am respectively dressed in their FHC attire.

### 11 'Going Forth' Mass

St Paul's children's will receive their FHC certificate at the 'Going Forth' mass on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2020 at 9.15am.
