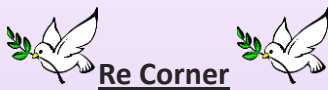
Friday 24th September 2021

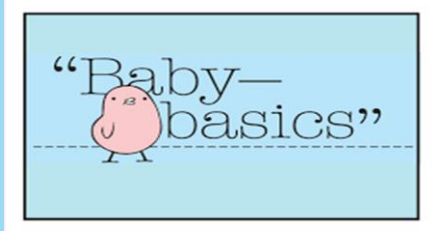
