

Thanks to your support, our churches and Parish buildings are in good condition, having spent over £52,206 in the last 3 years on necessary repairs and maintenance. In the future we will have a major improvement at St Finbarr's and a major project for the Hall in Dover.



But did you know that...



Gift Aid is easy to do, doesn't cost you a penny and helps run and sustain our Parish its buildings and its contents.

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If you pay tax, you can easily Gift Aid, which automatically increases your donation by adding a quarter more at no cost to you.

- 50% of donations were Gift Aided in 2023
- If more people signed up to Gift Aid, we could receive up to an extra **£6,837** each year back from HMRC.

Gift Aid allows us to receive an extra 25p for every £1 you donate!

Standing Order is one of the best ways to support our Parish!

Methods of Giving 2023

A standing order is an instruction to your bank to make regular fixed payments to our Parish. This provides secure, regular income that is easy to Gift Aid, easy to reconcile and takes less time than counting loose change each week. You do not need to worry about getting cash each week for Mass.

You can set up your Standing Order next week all you need is your account number & sort code.

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
